Point in Time

The Point in Time count takes place annually on the last Wednesday of January. This year's PIT count was held on January 26, 2022, and counted 200 people who were literally homeless—staying in emergency shelter, transitional housing or in a place not meant for human habitation.



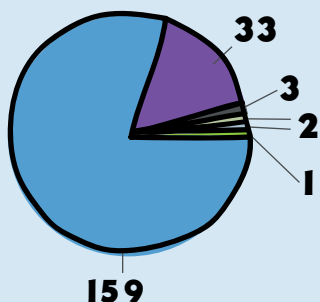
Total Number of People



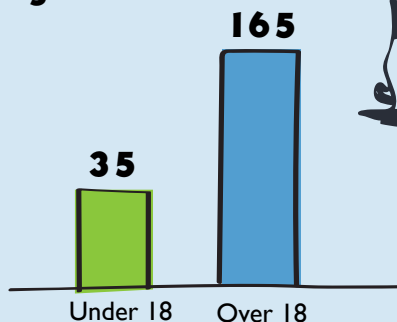

Age

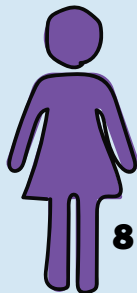

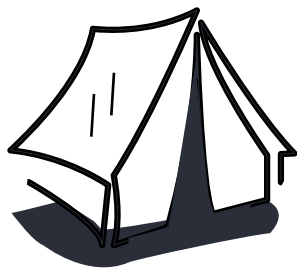

Nearly 18% of people experiencing homelessness on the night of the Point in Time count were verified as living in a car, tent, storage unit, or other place not meant for human habitation.



Over the course of the first quarter of 2022, the Community Action House Street Outreach Team connected with 155 individuals experiencing unsheltered homelessness.

The LHA is committed to bringing an end to homelessness.
